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

In 2021, Cheri and Rodney came to Arlington Life Shelter looking for a little extra support. The couple was financially stable enough to leave the program early, but when Cheri's health took a bad turn, medical bills began piling up.

Because of failing health, Cheri lost her job, and Rodney's mechanic business folded under the weight of the extra medical costs. Without income, the couple became homeless.

Thankfully, Cheri and Rodney knew where to go for help. "Arlington Life Shelter, from what I know, is the best of the best," Rodney says. "They give more than you could think."

helped host birthday parties, Bingo games and Christmas parties for many Shelter residents. She has shared hope, encouragement and care with everyone she meets. Now, she serves as the President of PALS.

"It's just nice to see that the shelter is helping people get back on their feet," she shares.

Because of her incredible resiliency and love for Chase, Vanessia kept pushing on. She got a job at an online retailer – but it was too late to keep her apartment, and the family was evicted.

Vanessia ensured that Chase could stay with his father while she searched for a solution.

Vanessia came to Arlington Life Shelter looking for a fresh start. Right away, she enrolled in the Shelter's programs and began taking charge of her new life.
